CELL PHONE POLICY

State Law allows students to have cell phones on campus in case of an emergency. On an elementary campus, we typically have some students with a cell phone in the upper grade-levels. However, cell phones are to be off while on campus and hidden from sight (e.g. stowed in backpack).

Students are forbidden from using cell phones during the school day to:

- Call or receive phone calls
- Send or receive text messages
- Take photographs
- Record students or staff

Cell phones seen or heard will be taken. It is the parent's responsibility to pick up the cell phone from school. Disciplinary actions may also be taken for continued defiance. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones.

BIKE/SKATEBOARD/SCOOTER – “Wheels” – RULES

1. Students must wear a helmet to and from school by law.
2. Students must walk their “wheels” while on campus, to and from the Bike Rack, near the southeast side of the auditorium.
3. Students cannot touch anyone else's belongings in the Bike Rack.
4. Students are not to hang around the Bike Rack area, only students securing their “wheels” are to be in that area for drop off/pick up.
5. If a student does not follow the “wheels” rules, that student will not be allowed to ride any “wheels” to school.
