Dear Fletcher Hills Families,

As I write this I am stunned to realize that it is already mid-December and that we continue to work through the realities of this pandemic as individuals, as a school and as an entire community. We have one more week of school until our Winter Break begins. We will be back to our classes and friends on Tuesday, January 5th. I hope you all enjoy your holidays with your families and that you find joy in that time together.

One of our favorite PTA events of the year is Winter Craft Night. It was so difficult to let go of that tradition so our PTA and staff decided to host "Winter Craft Day". This Friday we will distribute crafts to all of our students (3 crafts per student). Teachers and students will spend time together making those crafts as part of their school day. In addition to your crafts students will receive a treat bag with some holiday treats and a packet for making coco or apple cider just as they'd enjoy if we were able to have a community craft night here on campus. .

Please check with your child's teacher as Kindergarten, TK and one or two other classes are scheduling times that are different from the rest of the school. The rest of us will drive by school for a special craft pick up on Friday, December 18 from 7:30-8:45 am. Zoom sessions will begin at 9:00 am that day in order to accommodate our craft pick up event. It will also be pajama day on zoom. **If you are unable to pick up your child's crafts on the morning of the 18th you can come by the school office to pick them up any day that week between 7:30 and 3:00.** We hope to see as many families as possible drive by Friday morning.

We are seeing more and more cases of COVID in our community. If a teacher has a family member who has a confirmed case of COVID, that teacher is required to work from home for 2 weeks. If there are students or staff members who have confirmed cases, all families will be notified while keeping the identity of the person confidential.
