## **SCHOOL POLICIES - QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE**

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Attendance	The best gift you can give your child is a good education. The best place to get that education is in school. Parents are required to monitor student health conditions. Students who are sick or display symptoms should remain home. It is essential that you call the office each day your child is absent. <b>Call the school office at (619) 668-5820 #2 or email each day your child is absent.</b> Independent Study Agreements (ISA) are available for students who will be out 1+ day. Completion of ISA work will give students credit for attendance.
After/Before School Care	<b>Extended School Services (ESS)</b> is available for students. Our site lead can be reached at (619) 668-5820 ext. 1381. More information is available on the <u>district website</u> , or by calling ESS directly at 619-644-3800.
Announcements	<b>School-Wide</b> information from the Principal is <b>emailed</b> Friday afternoons. Please plan to check your email for a message from "Fletcher Hills Campus" each Friday afternoon to remain well informed. You can also follow us on our social media accounts: Instagram, Twitter, and Facebook. <b>Classroom</b> announcements from your child's teacher will be communicated using email, Class Dojo or Jupiter.
Bikes/Scooters	Students in grades 4th-5th are permitted to ride their bikes/scooters to school. Students must wear a helmet to and from school by law. Students must walk their bikes/scooters while on campus to and from the bike rack. Helmets and locks are required if your child chooses to ride his/her bike/scooter to school. ALL students who ride a bike/scooter to school must have a Bike Contract on file in the office. Skates and wheelie shoes are not allowed on campus.
Birthdays	We know birthdays are special and would like to celebrate with you. <u>Food Treats are NOT ALLOWED.</u> No exceptions. Thank you for helping us to ensure the safety of our students with food allergies and to promote healthy eating habits for all. In lieu of cupcakes or food treats, please consider stickers, pencils, donating a book to the classroom or library or other non-food options for celebrating your child's birthday at school.
Clothing	<ul> <li>Your child's appearance is a direct reflection of pride in herself/himself and in her/his school.</li> <li>Face is visible</li> <li>Top has straps or sleeves</li> <li>Undergaments and private areas are not visible</li> <li>Closed toe shoes</li> <li>Closed toe shoes</li> <li>Closed toe shoes code. Please see full dress code on our website.</li> <li>Unacceptable Clothing: clothing that shows skin in the areas that are covered in the diagram above, clothing with words or pictures about alcohol, drugs, tobacco, gangs, or profanity, and sandals (close-toed shoes required per California State Law).</li> <li>Headgear must not be worn in a manner that hides a student's face, unless for religious, health, or other reasons approved by school administration.</li> </ul>
	If your child is not dressed appropriately, you may be called to bring your child a change of clothes.

*TK and Kindergarten students should keep a fresh set of underwear/pants in their backpack in case of an accident. We keep a very limited supply of replacement clothing in the office. Children will need to be picked up for other bathroom accidents.
<i>Students may not use personal cell phones or Smart Watches on campus.</i> Phones and Smart Watches must be <b>turned off and kept out of sight</b> . Calls will be generated from the office or directly from the classroom phone. Fletcher Hills is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged electronic devices that are brought on campus.

The curb in front of the school is for drop off/pick up <b>only</b> . When dropping off or picking up students, please pull forward as far as you can. Do not drop off or pick up children without pulling up to the curb. Students should not be dropped off or picked up from the staff parking lot at any time. Center Drive is busy at drop off/pick up times, <u>no U-turns are permitted</u> . We appreciate your assistance, use of good judgment, respectful consideration of others, and patience in keeping our students safe. Safety is our priority. *Please note that at the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year student drop off and pick up will take place on Tampa Ave. during construction.
No early check outs will be permitted between 2:00-2:15 (12:45-1:00 on Tuesdays). Be prepared to present your ID. You will be <b>required to sign your student out at the front office; your child will be called to the office after you have arrived at school.</b> Please plan accordingly as this can take a few minutes. If someone other than a parent or guardian is picking up your child, the parent/guardian must deliver a signed, dated letter notifying the office as to which emergency contact will be picking up the student with the date and time of that pick up. That person must show their ID upon pick up. If your child has an appointment during the day, please be sure your child is at school before and after the appointment.
FREE breakfast is available to all students 7:30 a.m7:50 a.m. in the auditorium. FREE lunch is available to all students daily. Children have 20 min. to eat & 20 min. to play. If your child brings food to school, please label your child's lunch box with his/her name and classroom. Snacks Per the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District Wellness Policy, children may bring healthy, nutritious snacks to school to eat during their morning recess time. Healthy Snacks Include: Fruits, vegetables, crackers, trail mix, pretzels, 100% juice. NOT Allowed at School: Gum, candy, soda, energy drinks, caffeine, LARGE bags of chips or cookies. ***Snacks must be snack size – large/family-size bags/containers of food will be sent home*** Students may NOT share food with other children due to allergies.
All students taking medication (of any kind) must have a doctor authorization (on our specific form) on file in our health office. An adult must bring properly labeled medication to the health office.
Parking is limited and available on nearby streets (Chatham St., Brockton St., etc.) Please never park in loading zones (yellow and white curbs), reserved parking spaces, or blocking a driveway.
<b>Label Everything.</b> Please put your child's name on all clothing, lunch boxes, backpacks, etc. to avoid loss. Found items are placed in our school Lost & Found, located in the lunch area. Personal items such as toys, sports balls, jewelry, novelty items, should not be brought to school.

School begins everyday at 7:55a.m. Dismissal is at 1:00pm on Tuesdays and 2:15p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. Campus opens at 7:45a.m. Students not eating breakfast go directly to the classroom (or Peace Circle on Fridays). If your child arrives after 7:55 he/she must enter through the front office to check in. Please ensure your child is picked up within 10 minutes of dismissal.
