Here are some additional details:

- You can attend one or both sessions (it's encouraged to visit the session that your child's teacher will be on campus). The family picnic/scavenger hunt will be the same both weeks.
- Please enter campus through the front gates. Upon entering, everyone will receive a temperature screening and we will log attendance.
- Masks are required, and social distancing with non-family members is expected at all times.
- To limit the number of people on campus, we ask that you/your child attend the designated time slots for their grade level, and stay only through the time allotted.
- Our cafeteria will not be offering lunch for the family picnic.
- Playgrounds will be closed, as they are being utilized for ESS students.
- ESS students will participate in the event on the day their teacher will be on campus.
- Lemon Avenue is a "no phone zone" for students, so phones must be turned off and in pockets while on campus.
- Students will be expected to practice respectful, responsible and safe behavior on campus, and we thank you in advance for your cooperation.

We understand this schedule may pose a challenge for families with multiple children, so while we encourage you to have children attend on their grade's given day/time, we know this may not always be possible. Just do your best!

Finally, this event is optional and not required. We will be sending additional information and guidelines for the return to campus for hybrid prior to April 19, so please understand this welcome to campus event is not an orientation or information session. This is simply a chance for you and your child to get reacquainted with our wonderful campus!
