We are looking forward to having your child in Room 26. This is an exciting time in your child's life. Many of you ask if there is anything you can do to help us. The following is a list of supplies that your student will be using throughout the year. If possible, we ask that you do the best you can to provide your child and your child's classroom with these materials. If you are unable to donate the supplies we will supply them for you. If you are able to donate more than suggested, it would be truly appreciated. We will send out requests for donations to replenish our supplies as needed throughout the year. All donated materials will be shared by all students in the classroom.

- * 6 Large Glue sticks (purple is easier for the kids to see)
- * 1 box baby wipes or refill bags
- * 1 ream white cardstock paper
- * 2 boxes Kleenex
- * 1 box Ziploc bags (gallon, quart, sandwich or snack) bags with sliders makes it easier on the kids).
- * Paper plates (small)
- * Wet Erase Pens (Visa Vis or other brand in various colors)
- * 1 canister Clorox wipes



Please make sure to send your child a lunch and snack each day with all items inside labeled with their name or initials inside their lunchbox. If your child is buying school lunch, be sure to let us know. If your student is buying school lunch, they will still need a daily snack. Your child will need a **full size** student backpack to transport their school folder and all required materials to and from school. I will give each child a folder on the first day of school to carry their papers to and from school. Please label all lunchboxes, backpacks and jackets with their name so we can ensure they get home to the proper family.
