We need your help! We are having a HUGE problem with tardies. On average we have 35 students tardy on a daily basis. Why so many tardies? Poor organization is the most common reason for lateness. People wait until the last minute, and then do not allow themselves enough travel time.

What can we do? In order to be on time for school, you should figure out how much time it takes you to travel from your house to school - **add ten to fifteen minutes to that number** - this gives you a little bit of leeway in case traffic is bad or there is an accident.

- Have your things organized so that you do not spend a lot of time hunting all over the house for clothes, books, keys, etc. Learn how long it normally takes you to get dressed and ready to leave again, **give yourself an extra ten minutes just in case**! It is better to be ready early than to be ten minutes late.
- Set your alarm and get up when it sounds don't get into the habit of "just another five minutes" because it will just make you late. If you are still tired when you wake up, then you need to start going to bed earlier - children need ten to twelve hours of sleep every day; adults need six to eight hours to be completely rested. If you spend a bit of time planning ahead, you can be on time every day.
