



Technology Device Agreement

READ CAREFULLY

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The La Mesa-Spring Valley School District ("District") provides technological devices to students (such as an iPad and/or Chromebook) to enable their access to additional learning resources inside and outside of the instructional day. By accepting a District device, _____ (INSERT PARENT'S NAME) ("Parent"), understand and accept the following rules and responsibilities related to my child's ("Student") use of District devices.

Student and Parent Responsibilities

- In order to access learning resources on District devices at home, Student will be required to have access to the Internet at home.
- District devices, including, but not limited to, all accessories, apparatus, cases, and/or equipment that is provided with the device(s), are the sole property of the District.
- Student shall not use District devices to harass, intimidate, harm, disparage, bully or threaten other students, staff, or other individuals, or to access, post, or display harmful or inappropriate matter that promotes any activity prohibited by law, Board policy, or administrative regulations.
- District devices shall remain under the control and supervision of the District, and Student shall have no expectation of privacy on District devices. The District reserves the right to monitor, collect and/or inspect District devices for improper use without advance notice to, or consent from, Student or Parent.
- Student must protect their personal usernames and passwords. Unless otherwise instructed by school personnel, Student shall not disclose, use, or disseminate personally identifiable information related to him/her or others when using email, chat rooms, or other forms of direct electronic communication.
- Student shall not deliberately or willfully cause damage, destroy, modify, or abuse District device hardware or software in any way. Student and Parent shall exercise reasonable care for District devices at home to ensure such devices are not damaged or lost. All protective materials, such as protective cases, must remain on District devices at all times. District devices should be stored in a safe and secure location and kept out of reach of young children and pets. Devices must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels that are not the property of the District. District affixed labels and tags shall not be removed from devices.
- The District assumes no liability for lost, stolen, or damaged devices issued to Student. Lost, stolen or broken equipment should be reported to the school administrator/designee immediately. If the device is lost, stolen, broken, or not returned at the end of the school year, Parent will be responsible for the cost of replacing the device (Approximately \$245 for the replacement of a Chromebook or approximately \$300 for the replacement of an iPad).

LMSV Schools Responsibility

- The District Information Technology Department will be responsible for repairing devices that malfunction. Please report all hardware and/or software issues to your school administrator/designee.

My child will follow the rules outlined above and any school rules or policies that may apply to the use of the devices. I give my permission for my child to check out the District device.
