Blended Learning Weekly Overview

--Students attend campus classes **ONLY on the day they are assigned (A,B,C, or D day).** The other days, students are home. Your learning group is listed in your Infinite Campus Portal.

- Monday: Teachers share weekly goals and schedules. Students stay home.
- Tuesday A day or Distance Learning
- Wednesday B day or Distance Learning
- Thursday C day or Distance Learning
- Friday D day or Distance Learning

Distance Learning ONLY Weekly Overview

-- Students remain home and do not attend any on campus classes. Students should log-in to their courses daily and complete the assignments for their classes. Please email teachers if your student needs help. We also have tutorial times available via Zoom.

- APPOINTMENTS WITH YOUR COUNSELOR: Please email your counselor and request a phone appointment during available times. Please leave detailed information in the email and your counselor will return your email with an appointment confirmation.
- CHANGE TO QUARTER SYSTEM FOR 2020-2021: Our school district has decided to move to a modified alternating quarter system for this school year. Each term is only 9 weeks long. This means you will be issued final grades every 9 weeks and these grades will be reported on your official transcript. Here is a breakdown:
 - \circ Quarter 1 (Periods 1, 3, 5, 7) August 10, 2020 to October 9, 2020

- \circ $\,$ Quarter 2 (Periods 2, 4, 6) October 12, 2020 to December 18, 2020 $\,$
- Quarter 3 (Periods 1, 3, 5, 7) January 11, 2021 to March 12, 2021
- Quarter 4 (Periods 2, 4, 6) March 29, 2021 to June 7, 2021
- QUARTER 1: PERIODS 1,3,5,7 General Weekly Overview:
 - Monday: Teachers share weekly goals and schedule
 - Monday Friday: Students work on activities, teachers provide feedback, messaging, chatting, etc.
 - Tuesday / Thursday: Live Class Schedule
 - Period 1: 10:00am 11:00am
 - Period 3: 11:30am 12:30pm
 - Wednesday / Friday: Live Class Schedule
 - Period 5: 10:00am 11:00am
 - Period 7: 11:30am 12:30pm
 - Teacher and student contact is expected each day through one or more of the following activities: class updates, delivery/collection of assignments, feedback on assignments, live whole class or small group meetings (Zoom or Google Meet), messaging with Google Chat, email, Campus Messenger, Remind or Schoology
- **RELEASE OF CLASS SCHEDULES:** Students will be able to view their schedules in their Infinite Campus Portal beginning August 7th at 4 pm. If you need help accessing your postal you can visit the <u>Infinite Campus Guide</u>
- ACCESS TO INFINITE CAMPUS: Please see our district's <u>Infinite Campus Guide</u> for more information and guidance on how to access your Infinite Campus portal.
- **PERCEIVED GAPS IN SCHEDULE:** When you access your schedule and you notice a hole or a "gap" in your schedule, please do not panic. If a student has classes periods 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 but is missing a class Period 2, this is NOT a gap. The reason is because we are in a quarter system and period 2 would be the first period of the day for that quarter. It just means you start later that day. 6 classes is considered a complete schedule.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION for 20-21 school year: Please complete these in your parent's Infinite Campus portal as soon as possible.

 - **Continuing Students:** You must complete 20-21 online registration which can be found on our <u>school website</u> or can be updated in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

- OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS: See school website for <u>Active Students</u> to request transcripts with Mr. Alan Garcia, Site Support Technician <u>ajgarcia@guhsd.net</u> all "in person" and "pick up" options are not available at this time as the school is closed.
- CHROMEBOOKS: GUHSD is a 1:1 District, where every student receives a device. The chromebook schedule is:
 - All Incoming 9th graders will pick up their computers on August 3rd or 4th, between 8am and 2pm at the front office.
 - Chromebook repairs are available Monday-Friday 9am-12pm in Room 201.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Can I still talk to my counselor about my classes? Yes, you can email your Counselor above with questions, however we are not making schedule changes at this time.
- Can I take my classes in the Learning Center for the remainder of the semester since we are doing distance learning anyway? The Learning Center is for seniors to make up credits that they need to graduate. If you are a senior and feel you should be in the Learning Center, please contact your counselor.
- I am a senior who needs this year's PE credits. Will I still be getting my PE credits to graduate since we are now doing distance learning? PE will also be transitioning to online distance learning just like all other classes. Please communicate with your PE teacher directly and keep up with the online work in PE to ensure you earn a "D" or higher.
- Last year the district announced a Do-No-Harm grading policy. Will that apply this year? Do grades this semester still count and do we still need 220 credits to graduate? At this time, graduation requirements have not been adjusted. Unless we hear otherwise, letter grades and citizenship grades will still be issued at the end of every quarter. You will still need 220 credits to graduate.
- I am feeling sad or overwhelmed and I need someone to talk to. Who can I go to for help? Your counselor is a great resource and can be reached via email. We also have our Mending Matters team who can assist you. Our
