ROLL CALL VOTE

As authorized by Education Code section 42127, the San Diego County Superintendent of Schools shall determine whether our adopted budget will allow the District to meet its financial obligations during the fiscal year and is consistent with a financial plan that will enable the District to satisfy its multiyear financial commitments. As a condition of County budget approval in these extraordinary fiscal times and due to the magnitude of the reductions needed in the multiyear projections, the District is being asked to submit additional documentation to show fiscal solvency.

The District will work closely with the Budget Study Committee, bargaining units, and the Board in the coming months to determine what additional reductions will be implemented. A detailed list of the reductions totaling the amount needed for solvency in 2011-12 will be submitted to the Board with the First Interim report in December. These reductions are currently projected at \$12 million.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the Board adopt the <u>attached</u> Resolution 10-11-03, to Identify the Amount of Budget Reductions Needed in 2011-12 and 2012-13 and to Require that a List of Budget Reductions for 2011-12 be Included in the 2010-11 First Interim.

RESOLUTION 10-11-03

TO IDENTIFY THE AMOUNT OF BUDGET REDUCTIONS NEEDED IN 2011-12 AND 2012-13 AND TO REQUIRE THAT A LIST OF BUDGET REDUCTIONS FOR 2011-12 BE INCLUDED IN THE 2010-11 FIRST INTERIM REPORT

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has a fiduciary duty to meet its financial obligations in the current fiscal year and two subsequent fiscal years pursuant to Education Code 42127; and

WHEREAS, due to the budget reductions proposed in the Governor's 2010-11 May Revision, the Board of Education approved \$12.2 million in budget reductions and solutions to balance the 2010-11 budget; and

WHEREAS, for 2011-12 and 2012-13, it is projected that the district will need to implement budget reductions of \$12 million and \$14.3 million respectively; and

WHEREAS, while these actions must be taken to maintain the fiscal stability of the district, the Board of Education will continue to make every effort to sustain a high quality education program for our students; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, if the Governor's May 2010 Revision is enacted as proposed, or if the fiscal condition further deteriorates, the district will implement \$12 million in budget reductions in 2011-12 and \$14.3 million in reductions in 2012-13.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the district will submit a detailed list of Board-approved budget reductions for 2011-12 and a timeline for making budget reductions with the 2010-11 First Interim Report. This resolution reaffirms the adopted budget approved on June 29, 2010 and becomes supplemental to that action.
