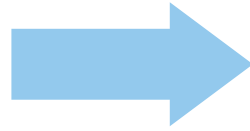


DIDN'T FILE A TAX RETURN?

You may still be eligible for more than \$1,200
from the Federal Government

Are you a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident who did not file a tax return in 2018 or 2019?



You need to complete a simple form to receive your **Economic Impact Payment** from the Federal Government!



Eligibility requirements:

- You must be a U.S. Citizen or legal permanent resident
- Have a valid social security number
- Could not be claimed as a dependent of another taxpayer
- Did not file a 2018 or 2019 tax return
- Your income in 2019 was less than \$12,200 for an individual or \$24,400 for a couple
- You do not receive Social Security, VA, or Railroad Retirement Benefits

Note: If you filed a tax return, or receive Social Security, VA, or Railroad Retirement Benefits – you do not need to fill out additional paperwork to receive your payment



Fill out this simple form and you will receive up to **\$1,200** per adult and **\$500** per dependent under 17 from the Federal Government:

If you did not file a 2018 or 2019 tax return, and your income is more than \$12,200 for an individual or \$24,400 for a couple and less than \$99,000 for an individual or \$198,000 for a couple (without children) – you are still eligible for an Economic Impact Payment.

To receive it, you must fill out a 2019 tax return by July 15.
