**REPORTS - Measure V Program**

Review of the audit report for the year ending June 30, 2024, presented by Kyle Montgomery from Christy White. The auditors found no significant findings or recommendations on the financial statements and performance audit. The audit team then discussed the budget for Measure V, which includes a breakdown of funds allocated to various projects and expenses.

Dan Young, Robert Cochran and Mark Claussen and the Kitchell team gave an update on Measure V. construction projects including La Mesa Dale Elementary, Lemon Avenue Elementary, Maryland Avenue Elementary, Parkway Middle School, STEAM Academy's upper field and the Education Center. The budget allocation and remaining funds were also discussed.

An explanation of the energy efficiency project and how it was funded was also shared with CBOC committee members. Presentation on turf overlays on playgrounds and the use of wood chips over other surfaces.

Overview of the upcoming activities, such as the construction of the STEAM upper field, the education center and the potential use of remaining funds for priority district projects.

Presentation on non-Measure V facility improvements and a discussion of the overall success of the bond program.

### **CBOC Communications**

Amanda-Dawn Natalia requested language from the bond agreement regarding the energy efficiency project.

Jay Steiger requested the preparation of a brief presentation on improvements not funded by Measure V. Additionally, he asked that the presentation emphasize how the bond program contributes to reducing the backlog of deferred maintenance.
