Invitation/Application for: Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) Measure V General Obligation Bond

Overview of the CBOC

In November of 2020, voters of the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District approved a One Hundred Thirty-Six Million Dollar (\$136,000,000) bond measure to upgrade and construct school facilities throughout the District. Following the bond's approval, the District established a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to provide independent oversight of bond expenditures.

The Committee serves in an advisory capacity and does not have decision-making authority. Members review quarterly general obligation bond progress reports, budget information, audits, and expenditure reports to help ensure bond proceeds are used for the purposes described in the ballot measure. The Committee also communicates its findings to the public.

Current Need

The District is seeking qualified candidates to fill the following two (2) vacancies for two-year terms:

1. One (1) Business Community Representative: An active member of a business organization representing the business community located within the boundaries of the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District. The applicant's qualifying business affiliation or venture must be located within the District's boundaries.
2. One (1) Member at Large: A community member who resides within the boundaries of the La Mesa-Spring Valley School District.
